

Biographical Sketch for Jean Moran:

Dr. Jean Moran is on the faculty in the Department of Earth and Environmental Science at California State University, East Bay. Her research focuses on using natural and artificial isotopes to examine geochemical and transport processes in the vadose zone and in groundwater. She was principal investigator and LLNL project director for the Groundwater Ambient Monitoring and Assessment project sponsored by the California State Water Resources Control Board from 2001-2007. Dr. Moran has a Ph.D. in Geochemistry from the University of Rochester, Bachelor's degrees in physics and geology from the University of Rochester and a Master's degree in geophysics from the University of Washington. She has authored or co-authored more than 25 peer-reviewed publications and has been a GRA Board member since January, 2006.
