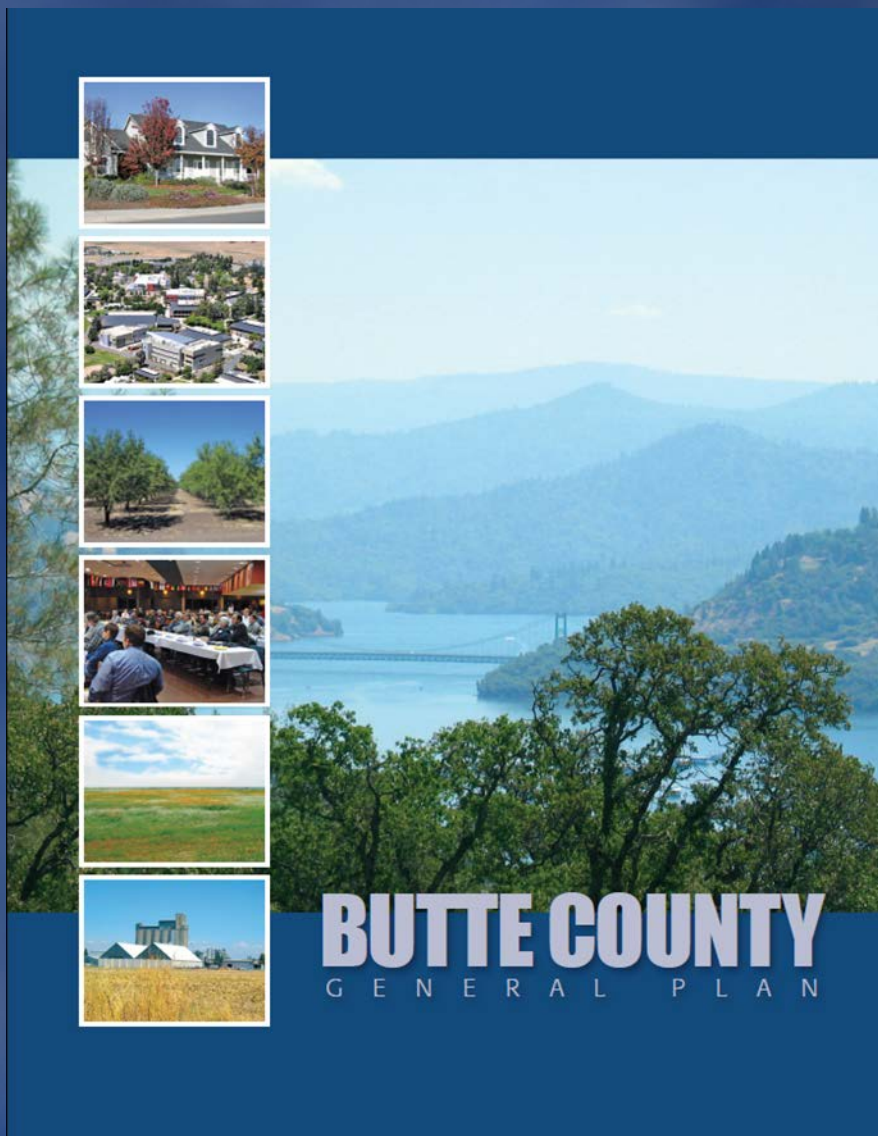

- Presumed to be the GSA for unmanaged areas



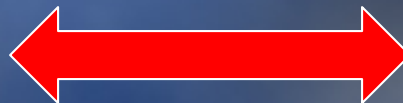

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Water Resources Element

Water Commission & Planning Commission

Key topics

- *Recharge area protection*
- *Water supply reliability*
- *Assessment of impacts on the basin*
- *Sustainability*





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Water Resource Element

Compilation of existing programs and policies

New Policies/Action Items

- ***Low Impact Development (LID)***
- ***Assessment of groundwater impacts to surrounding groundwater users and the environment***
- ***Promotion of groundwater recharge***



The Butte County General Plan Water Element Experience

Lessons Learned

Informed the process

- *Water budget*
- *Monitoring*
- *Hydrologic conceptual model (recharge)*
- *All data/analysis became part of the DEIR*
- *Modified some proposed growth areas*

“You can’t always get what you want....”

Can never avoid litigation

Created a new institutional relationship

Two way dialogue & collaboration

- *Water budget update*
- *Routine collaboration*
